# Love to Read Week Next Week Let's Celebrate the Big 4-0!

Christian Academy Schools is celebrating our 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary! It is so exciting to see how faithful God has been over these 4 decades! Love to Read Week will be celebrating the Big 4-0, **February 11<sup>th</sup> – February 15<sup>th</sup>**.

Beginning Monday, **February 11<sup>th</sup> at 8:20 a.m.**, students will be challenged to read 40 minutes each day until Friday, **February 15<sup>th</sup> 8:20 a.m.** Each day that students achieve this goal, their names will be entered for special prize drawings. Prizes will include an Amazon gift card, a Walmart gift card, and several books that were published 40 years ago! You might be surprised at some of the characters who are the same age as CAS. Any student who completes the challenge every day will receive ice cream at lunch on Friday!

Students are to keep track of all their reading minutes for the week on the supplied log sheets. They need to hand in their log sheets to their teachers each morning to get their name entered for the day. All entries need either a parent's or a teacher's signature. All reading must be from a choice book (do not include reading from magazines, textbooks, assigned books for class, catalogs, etc.)

#### What reading may count towards the Reading Challenge?

- Daily Love to Read 20 minutes of silent reading
- Silent reading at home
- Silent reading during study halls
- Silent reading during class time if the teacher approves

#### What does **NOT** count for the Reading Challenge?

- Reading magazines, textbooks, catalogs, etc.
- Reading aloud in reading groups
- Someone reading to them (Note: ONLY Kindergarten and 1st grade may count all minutes that someone reads to them since they are still learning to read.)

#### Other events will include:

- **Daily Trivia Contest**. Questions will be posted on the front bulletin board. Students answer the questions and those with the correct answer will go into a daily drawing for a candy bar.
- 20 minutes of Silent Reading.
- **Book Exchange** for all students grades K-12. Students bring in gently used books and will have an opportunity to trade them for a different book.
- Coffee and Hot Chocolate Bar. High School students will start each morning with coffee or hot chocolate and general literacy discussions.
- Book Wars. Middle School students will pit book against book in a battle to determine the best book in the library.
- Guest Readers. Elementary students will enjoy hearing stories from special guest readers each morning.

#### **Book Exchange for High School & Elementary**

Beginning Monday, February 11<sup>th</sup> through Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup>, tables will be located in the hallway. Students can bring in books, CD's, DVD's for an exchange. When they bring these items in, each student will receive a colored ticket for each book that goes along with what age group the book is written for.

These tickets will be used to purchase the same age appropriate books, CD's, or DVD's on Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup>. Books, CD's, and DVD's should be appropriate in content for Christian Academy standards. Make sure all exchanges are age appropriate. For example, for high school make sure books are appropriate for young adults.
