So How Is Your Herd?

“Know well the condition of your flocks, and pay attention to your herds;” Proverbs 27:23

For anyone who has ever been associated with farming including the raising of livestock, understands the importance of what the writer was saying here in this brief passage. Money or even power can pass but the ongoing benefits of food, clothing and new revenue generated by the flock was of far greater value. Farmers and herdsman knew they had to place greatest importance on that which would bring the greatest long-term benefits on their investment.

Last week in a devotional I shared with our staff we talked about this principle in working with our students on a daily basis. For each of us daily it is important to know well the condition of the “flocks” that the Lord has entrusted us with. Where are they spiritually, academically, socially, physically, and so on. Knowing those conditions then working to make sure they are “healthy in all areas” is crucial not only for now but for the future. It is these students who will in the long-term provide the greatest return on our investment of time and resources.

So, even as a parent we must also ask this same question when our kids are not at school.how is the condition of the flock that God has given me? Knowing this answer and then acting upon it will help ensure our herd will experience and provide the greatest long-term/eternal benefits.

CAS Class Basket Phone-In Auction Saturday November 21st from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

We are so very thankful for all the donations and work that has gone into making our beautiful class baskets this year. Typically, we would be holding an on-site write in auction for these during the spaghetti dinner. Even before we made the decision due to COVID concerns to postpone the dinner we realized that the normal format to raise funds through the baskets with potentially fewer people in attendance would have to be altered. Various options were considered including online auctions, raffles etc. but each presented in our circumstances some challenges. With this in mind we have decided for this year to do a timed phone in auction for bidding on each basket. The baskets have been and will continue to be shown via our newsletter for contents. We will have a set starting bid for each basket based upon approximately 25% of the baskets real value. Bidding will be increased by at least \$5 per bid.

There will be an assigned 30 -minute time frame on Saturday November 21st where those wanting to bid can call the school with people standing by to take bids. (937-492-7556) At the end of the 30 -minute time frame the highest bidder will get to purchase that basket at that price. We then move directly onto the next basket for bidding for another 30-minute time frame. This will be the format until all baskets are sold. Keep in mind this is a fundraising auction for CAS and not a looking for bargains event. All proceeds help with the ongoing expenses of the school. Below is the anticipated schedule for the baskets:

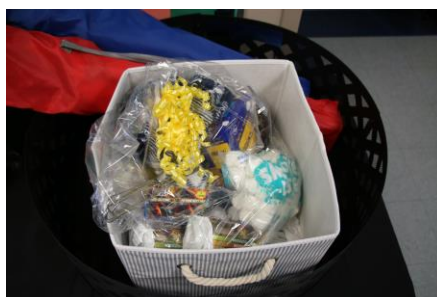
