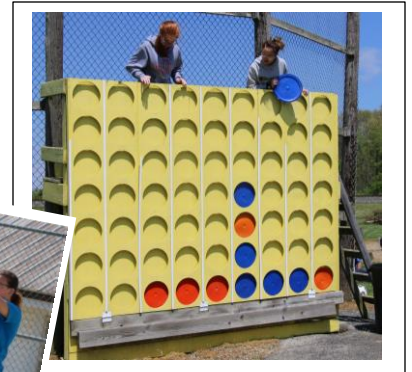
Verse of the Week
