Permission to Administer Medicine Information

Mrs. Inman will need a signed medicine form on file to be able to administer any medicine to your student. This includes ibuprofen or Tylenol for general headaches, allergy medicine or other "over the counter" medications. If your student should need to take daily prescribed medications or emergency items such as inhalers or EpiPen's, etc., this form also needs to be signed by the prescribing physician.
