High School students will be job shadowing on **Thursday, October 14**th. Job Shadowing is an academically motivating activity designed to give students the unique opportunity of an up-close look at the world of work. Students will "shadow" workplace mentors as they go through a normal day on the job. The program invites students to see firsthand how the skills learned in school relate to the workplace. This experience supports career exploration, which is an extremely important part of every child's education. Also, it helps students to solidify their career choice with more hands-on experience; as well as more opportunities to ask professionals good questions.
