CAS Class Basket Phone-In Auction Saturday, November 6th from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

We are so very thankful for all the donations and work that is going into making our beautiful class baskets this year. Typically, we would be holding an on-site write in auction for these baskets during the spaghetti dinner. Even before we made the decision due to various concerns to cancel the dinner, we realized that the normal format to raise funds through the baskets would have to be altered. With this in mind we have decided for this year to do a timed phone-in auction for bidding on each basket. The baskets have been and will continue to be shown via our newsletter for contents. We will have a set bid for each basket based upon approximately 25% of the baskets real value. Bidding will be increased by at least \$5 per bid. Last year we did this format, and it was a huge success.

There will be an assigned 30-minute time frame on Saturday, November 6th where those wanting to bid can call the school with people standing by to take bids. (937-492-7556) At the end of the 30-minute time frame the highest bidder will get to purchase that basket at that price. We then move directly onto the next basket for bidding for another 30-minute time frame. This will be the format until all baskets are sold. Keep in mind this is a fundraising auction for CAS and not a looking for bargains event. All proceeds help with the ongoing expenses of the school. Below is the anticipated schedule for the baskets:

- Bidding will ONLY be for that particular basket during the assigned time frame.
- Starting bids pre-set and increase in bidding are \$5 minimum. Bidding for each end at the conclusion of each time period.
- The baskets MUST BE picked up and PAID FOR by Monday, November 8th and Tuesday, November 9th during school hours!
