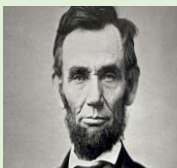

## March is Re-Enrollment Month for the 2022-23 School Year

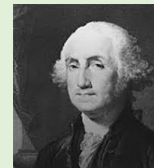

### Welcome, Mrs. Mahan

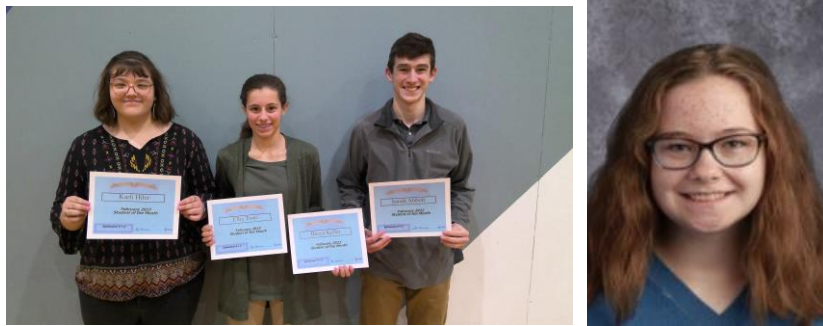
