# Message from Our Schools Registered Nurse

## Immunization Requirement for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Entry

One (1) dose of TDAP and Meningococcal vaccines **MUST** be administered PRIOR to entry into 7<sup>th</sup> Grade  
Tetanus-Diphtheria-acellular Pertussis (whooping cough)

Tdap can be given regardless of interval since the last tetanus-or diphtheria-toxoid containing vaccine  
Meningococcal (MCV4 – serogroup, A, C, W, and Y)

## Immunization Requirement for 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Entry

All students entering the 12<sup>th</sup> grade **ARE REQUIRED** to be vaccinated against meningococcal (serogroups A, C, W, and Y) disease. If the first dose was received prior to the age of 16, a second dose of meningococcal vaccine **is required**. The second dose must be administered on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday with at least eight weeks between the first and second dose. If the first dose of meningococcal vaccine was administered after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, a second dose is **not required**. **A waiver is available if your child is exempt from shots.**
