



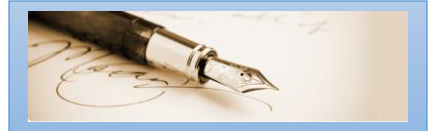

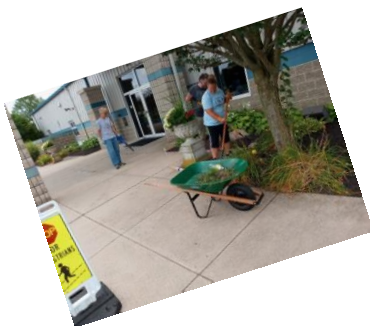

Permission to Administer Medicine Information

Mrs. Mahan will need a signed medicine form on file to be able to administer non-prescription and prescription medicines to your student.
