Wear anything and everything tie-dye to show your team spirit. We hope to see you there!



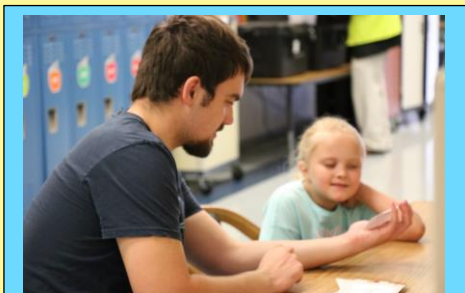




**Volcano Project**
