Tell Others about the EdChoice Scholarship

If a family's household income is at or below 450 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, they will be awarded the maximum scholarship amount. If a family's household income is at or above 451 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, the student's scholarship award will be prorated based on their specific percentage of the Federal Poverty Level. 100% of Ohio families will qualify for the Ed Choice Scholarship.

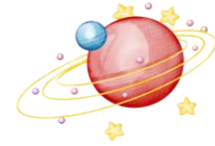


Kindergarten Screening

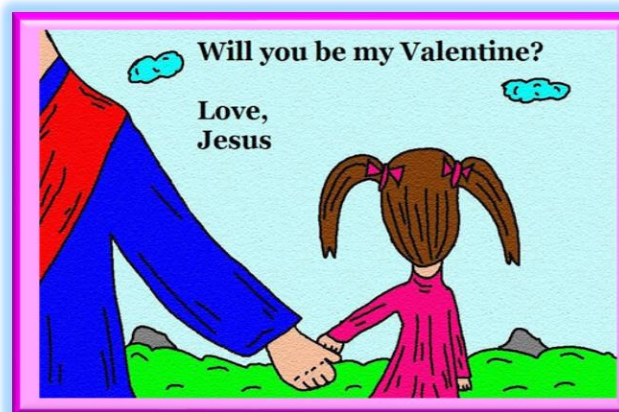
Middle School & High School Small Groups
