No Lack of Good Things Going On.....

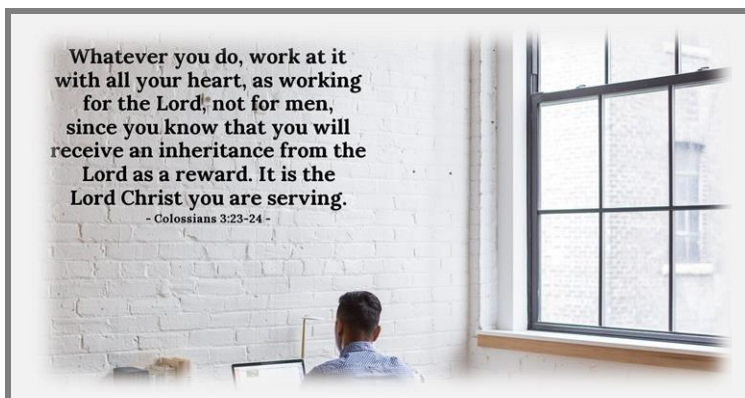
Over the past couple of weeks our students and staff have been busy with several notable events taking place both on campus and off campus. Below are just a few of those events:

Iowa Standardized Testing Continues Next Week

- *What grades will be participating?* **ALL GRADES**
- *What are the dates?* **Grades Kindergarten & grades 4-11** will test on **Monday, April 15th – Friday, April 19th**.
- *What is the Iowa Standardized Test?* This national test is designed to measure concepts, processes, and objectives taught throughout the nation in reading, language, mathematics, science, and social studies. The ACSI edition includes the Bible assessment subtest and five additional PLUS tests for assessment in word analysis, vocabulary, spelling, language mechanics, and math computation. This complete testing program will provide teachers and parents with valuable and in-depth information in all subject areas.
- *What can parents do to help?* Make sure your child receives plenty of sleep, eats a nutritious breakfast, and is encouraged to do his/her best.
- *Can the child miss school?* Only if your child is ill. It is hard to make up test. **Please do not schedule appointments during the week your child will be taking the Iowa Test.** It is important that your child is in attendance.
