Progress and Praise.....

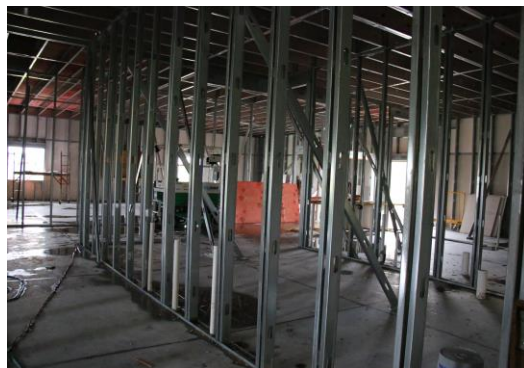
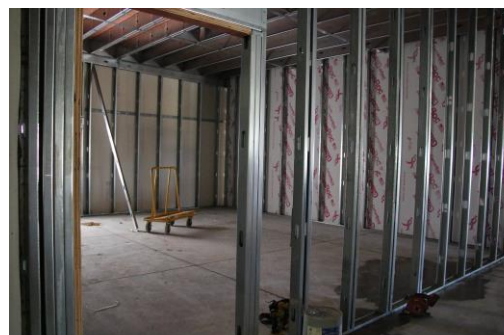
It is exciting each day to see what the Lord is doing with the new addition project here at CAS that will directly benefit every student and staff beginning in August of 2024! After breaking ground back in early March, we have now reached the point where the walls are all framed, the roof trussing is all in place, the exterior wall covering is attached, and the roofing materials are now being applied. All of this is towards the finished project which includes a large band/orchestra room, a vocal music/strings room, two general classrooms, a small storage area and new men’s and women’s restrooms/changing rooms for athletics.

We are so grateful to see how God continues to bring in the needed funds for the project. Our hope would be to see all the funds in or pledged by the end of this 23-24 school year. This year our spring Walkathon funds project is the new addition. As of today, we have received in cash or pledges over \$717K towards our need of \$1M for the project. The total amount includes over \$22K thus far from Walkathon funds that have come in. These funds also represent over 320 individuals or businesses that have given or pledged to give. The work, prayers and giving are ongoing as we press on towards all God wants to accomplish here. Even as Paul shared in Philippians 4:19, “My God shall supply all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus.”
