Back at our Christmas Concert here at CAS we formally rolled out our decision to add some much-needed space onto our current facilities. Rooms for music, regular instruction, storage, and restrooms were included. We knew that the price tag of \$1 million dollars would be a real stretch but would not be too big for the Lord. As of today, we have the new addition fully enclosed and watertight with work ongoing. The general contractor is still giving us a completion time of early August 2024 so that we will be using those classrooms for the 24-25 school year. We have seen the Lord provide over \$772,000 in cash and pledges this far. PTL! We are trusting Him for the remaining almost \$230K in the next few months. Thanks for your continued prayers and support.

We are also so very thankful that our Walkathon efforts by our students, families and staff that have seen over \$63,000 come in which is now included in that new addition total which has been our project for the year. Thank you so very much for your prayers and participation.

Even though for many we will be out of sight we do not want to be out of mind with prayers for the final funds needed and for some volunteer help that will be needed in late July and early August to get last minute details ready for school to open including the new addition.

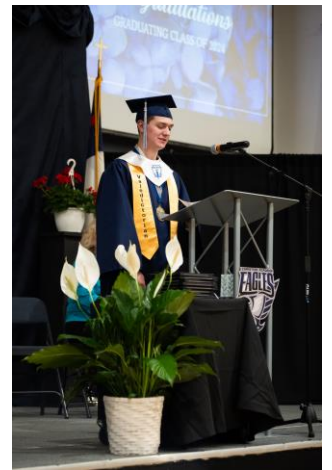
