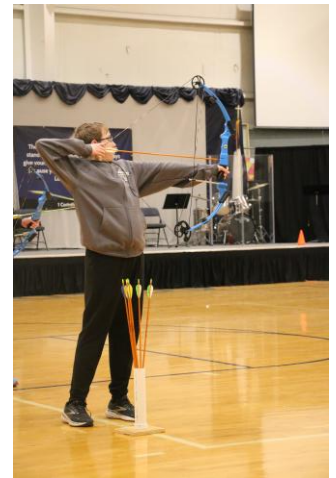


Congratulations, Savannah Baughman
