Renewed Knowledge

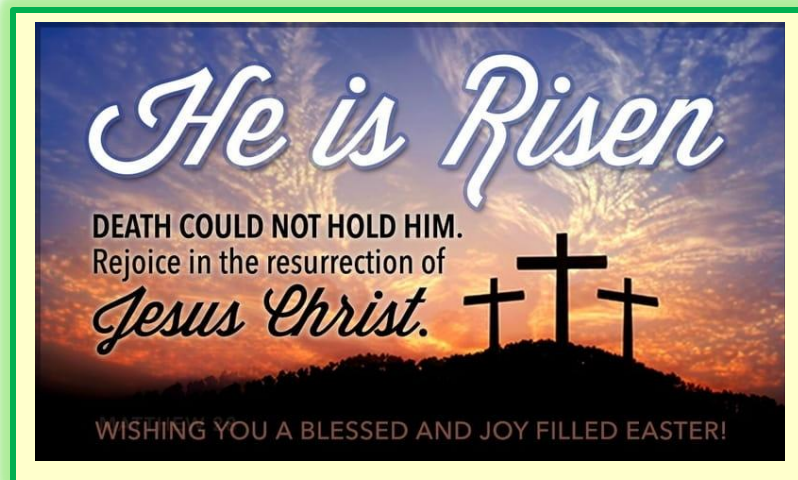

Chess Club Championship Game was Held on Wednesday, April 16th

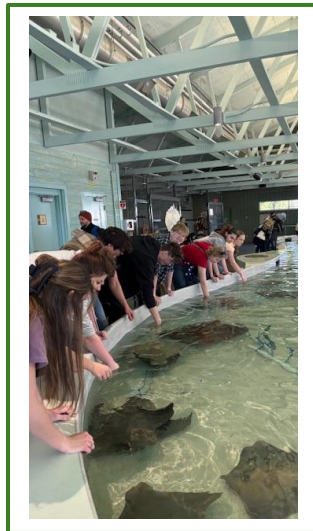
