



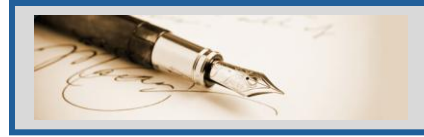

The stores are already putting out school supplies. Attached is the 26-27 School Supply List If you want to get a head start on buying your child's supplies.

Ohio's Tax-Free Holiday

Ohio's Tax-Free Weekend runs from **12am Friday, August 7th** through **11:59pm Sunday, August 9th**. The state limits the tax exemption to specific back-to-school items

- **Clothing:** Priced at **\$75 or less** per item.
- **School Supplies:** Priced at **\$20 or less** per item.
- **School Instructional Materials:** Priced at **\$20 or less** per item.

The exemption breaks down:

- **Qualifying Clothing:** Any human wearing apparel suitable for general use—such as shoes, coats, uniforms, and diapers—qualifies as long as the retail price is \$75 or less. Accessories, sports equipment, and protective gear do not qualify.
- **Qualifying School Supplies:** Items commonly used by students in a course of study. This includes binders, book bags, calculators, glue, folders, markers, and paper under \$20 each.
- **Qualifying Instructional Materials:** Textbooks, workbooks, reference books, maps, and globes priced at \$20 or less.
- **Non-Exempt Items:** Electronics, food, alcohol, and any of the qualifying items priced over their respective caps are subject to the standard 5.75% state sales tax (plus local county add-ons).
